
ABOUT IIHP

ABOUT GWALIOR

Gwalior, a major city in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh, is a historic city that has been ruled by several Indian kingdoms. Located 343 kilometers south of Delhi, the capital city of India, and 120 kilometers from Agra, Gwalior occupies a strategic location in the Gird region of India. The city is known for its rich history, reflected most famously in its fort, but also in the architecture of other buildings.

Gwalior's history dates back to the 10th century, with the Kachchhapaghatas being the earliest known rulers. The city was later passed on to the Tomars in the 13th century, the Mughal Empire, the Maratha in 1754, and finally the Scindia Dynasty of the Maratha Empire in the 18th century.

The city is also known as a center of Indian classical music, art, and literature. It has a rich cultural heritage and has been home to many notable people. The city's metropolitan area includes Gwalior City Center, Morar Cantonment, Lashkar-Gwalior (Lashkar Subcity), Maharaj Bada, Phool Bagh and Thatipur.

In addition to its cultural and historical significance, Gwalior is also an important industrial and political center. It was the winter capital of the state of Madhya Bharat, which later became a part of the larger state of Madhya Pradesh. Today, Gwalior is home to many administrative offices of the Chambal division of northern Madhya Pradesh.

Despite its bustling city life, Gwalior has not lost touch with its past. The city's historic rock fortress forms the center of the city and is a popular tourist attraction. Other attractions include the Jai Vilas Palace, the Sasbahu Temple and the Jhansi Ki Rani monument.
